EMERGENCY CLOSINGS

In case of emergency, for example, extreme weather conditions, serious building malfunctions, criminal activity, or by order of law, the Director shall notify the Board President and the Board President will decide whether to close the library and for what duration. If it is impracticable for the Director to notify the Board President because time is of the essence, for example, for an impending tornado, the Director shall make this decision.

If the emergency is continuing, the Director and the Board President shall notify the other Board of Trustees who will take appropriate action.

PERSONNEL POLICIES

D-5 (F) EMERGENCY CLOSINGS

When the library has an emergency closing, all employees who were scheduled to work during the closing will be compensated for their scheduled hours.
